



THE LIST OF PROHIBITED ITEMS IN HAND AND/OR HOLD BAGGAGE

Without an effect to the other aviation security provisions applied passengers are not allowed to carry in the airport security restricted area or onboard aircraft the following items:

- **→** Guns, Firearms and other devices that discharge projectiles
- Stunning devices
- Objects with sharp point or sharp edge
- Workmen's tools
- **Blunt instruments**
- Explosives and incendiary substances and devices

Additionally, in their hold luggage passengers are not allowed to carry explosives and incendiary substances, explosive devices, devices capable of being used to cause serious injury or may pose a threat to aircraft safety.

The list of prohibited items in hand or hold luggage is subject to change. We kindly advise passengers always to contact selected <u>air carrier</u>.



Guns, Firearms and other devices that discharge projectiles

Those are the devices capable, or appearing capable, of being used to cause serious injury by discharging a projectile including:

Objects with sharp point or sharp edge

Those are objects with a sharp point or sharp edge capable of being used to cause serious injury, including:

Explosives and incendiary substances and devices

Those are explosives and incendiary substances and devices capable or appearing capable, of being used to cause serious injury or to pose a threat to the safety of aircraft, including:
